TG4 content is available on all television platforms throughout Ireland, worldwide on the internet, and on digital platforms. TG4 is a public service broadcaster-publisher that sources the majority of its content from the independent production sector, content which has won many awards and accolades. TG4 is currently seeking to recruit Broadcast and Multimedia Support Engineers.

Irish is the working language of TG4. A positive attitude towards the language is essential for applicants. TG4 is an equal opportunities employer and eligible applications will be considered regardless of gender, sexual orientation, age, social background, race and ethnicity, disability, civil or family status, religion, or membership of the Traveller community. TG4 supports diversity and welcomes applications from people from a variety of backgrounds.

Reporting to the Engineering Manager in the Technology and Distribution Department, and working daily across departments with various TG4 teams, the successful candidates will be responsible for providing technical support for TG4 services across all platforms. These positions will involve shift work and weekend work.

TG4 wishes to recruit Broadcast and Multimedia Support Engineers who are motivated, experienced and technically skilled to join our Technology & Distribution Division at a time of change in TG4. This is an excellent opportunity for someone with experience or qualifications in Broadcast Technology or a related technical field.

You will play a key role in supporting TG4's broadcast systems and infrastructure across content production, video, audio, studio and other support on TG4 platforms support including a new digital news service to ensure smooth day-to-day operations across the station. You should be able to work independently and collaboratively and cross functionally as part of a dynamic team.

Among the responsibilities, but not limited to, will be:

- Provide day-to-day technical support to TG4 staff as prioritised by TG4 Director of Technology and Distribution
- Monitor and maintain TG4's technical infrastructure including broadcast and online systems.
- Carry out preventative maintenance and system health checks.
- Technical troubleshooting
- Respond to technical queries and issues raised through TG4's help desk system.
- Support the full media lifecycle – from commissioning, acquisition, and ingest, through to transmission and archiving.

- Contribute to the smooth operation of the station's technical facilities and workflows as prioritised by the organisation
- Participation in project-based work when required
- Any other reasonable duties as may be requested by your Manager, the Head of Department, or the Director General in line with the needs of the organisation.

The television industry is constantly evolving. TG4 embraces these changes and the organisation, as well as staff duties, will adapt accordingly.

Experience for the Role

- Minimum of 2 years' experience in a broadcast or relevant technical role.
- Degree or qualification in a related field (Broadcasting, Engineering, IT, Computer Science, etc.)
- TG4 seeks a self-starter who thrives in a busy environment and who works well independently and as part of a team.
- Understanding of the media environment.
- Proven ability to configure, troubleshoot, and maintain IP-based systems.
- Effective problem-solving and troubleshooting abilities.
- Broad knowledge of computer systems and IT infrastructure.
- A proactive attitude towards learning new skills, new technologies, and self-growth.
- Irish is the working language of TG4; a willingness to learn Irish and speak it in the workplace is essential. Training and classes will be provided where needed.
- You will succeed in this role if you are able to work confidently, flexibly, and effectively on your own initiative in a stimulating environment.
